We take only photographs, leave only footprints, and kill only time.

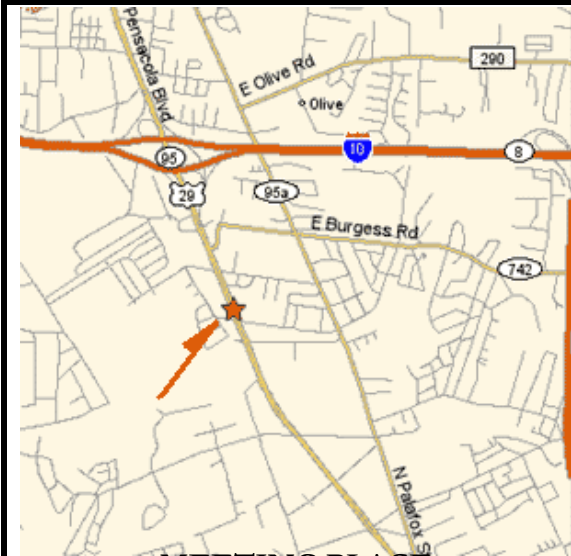
We strive to have minimal impact on the environment during our outings and to promote awareness of the necessity to protect and conserve the natural environment.

Dues

Dues are for membership from April 1st to March 31st of the following year. They help cover costs for the monthly newsletter, some club events, library material, etc.

One adult is (18 & over) \$10/yr. Additional adults (same address) are \$5/yr. Minor children (under 18), no additional fee.

Trips

Scheduled trips are published in the club newsletter and/or on the club website. Paddlers may sign up for trips during meetings or may call the trip coordinators to discuss the trip.

Guests are welcome to attend club trips, but must sign a waiver of liability. The club has a standing policy that members and guests are to refrain from bringing pets (unless invited by the trip coordinator) or radios to any club functions. Some trips may require skills or equipment as specified by the trip coordinator.

We also have a **TRIP HOTLINE** telephone number and email messaging for information on unscheduled outings. There usually are several HOTLINE trips each month. The trip coordinator appreciates prior notification of attendance or cancellation. These trips are only for members and their guests.

Waiver of Liability

For all members’ protection, each member has signed a waiver of liability as a condition of membership.

Canoeing, kayaking or rafting exposes the participant to various hazards. No one but me is responsible for my safety when I choose to run a particular river or body of water.
